



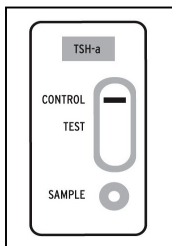
Reimbursement Guide for ThyroTest

An initial evaluation of a patient's TSH level. Use CPT Codes: 84443 or 84443QW

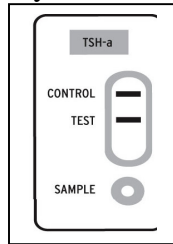
ThyroTest™ is run with two drops of fresh whole blood. The whole blood is collected from a finger stick using a provided pipette.

The ThyroTest™ test cassette is to be read 10 minutes after the samples and the buffer solution have been added to the sample well.

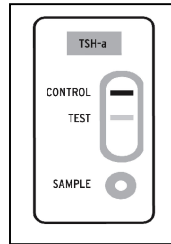
ThyroTest™ will then yield a result.



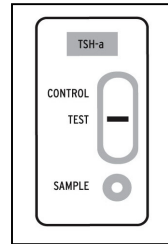

If the initial results from ThyroTest™ are positive, a secondary Thyroid Panel test will be required to confirm Hypothyroidism. This will require a separate blood draw from the patient to be sent to a qualified laboratory. If the results are negative, further panel testing is generally not recommended as ThyroTest™ is 95.5% accurate.

80091 Thyroid panel, includes Thyroxine (T4) total (84436) and Triiodothyronine (T3), resin uptake (84479).

80092 Thyroid panel with thyroid stimulating hormone (TSH) (84443) and includes (84436, 84479)
